## Pastoral Reflections

When an individual accepts Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior they are automatically enrolled as a soldier in the army of God. That army has been given a mission by its Commander and Chief to go and make disciples of all nations (Mt. 28:19). Once that mission is completed, once the gospel of the kingdom is preached in the whole world as a testimony to the nations, then the end will come (Mt. 24:14) and we can all go home.

As soldiers of the cross we have two options. 1) We can sit around on the sidelines and let others complete the mission, or 2)

we can be actively involved in completing the mission ourselves. I believe it is critical that we as a church are actively involved in completing the one mission, the Great Commission, given to us by God Himself.

Last month our church resolved to plant one church within 250 miles of our church by August 1, 2012. If we do not pursue this goal with energy and resolve then it will never be accomplished. Begin now with trying to determine how you will be involved with seeing this goal achieved.

Though I do not know all that will be required in

order to plant our new church, I am certain that it will begin with prayer. That is step #1 for our church. Therefore, mark your calendar for Friday, July 22, 2011 @ 7:00 PM for our first concert of prayer for the new church plant. At that time we will spend a focused time in prayer for our church and the new church plant. Stay tuned for more details about what a concert of prayer is if you have never been involved in one.

Secondly, I am in need of one individual who is willing to co-ordinate our prayer efforts for our new church plant with our shut-ins. It will require staying

in contact with them and informing them of new prayer requests as necessary.

Third, I want to encourage you all to begin praying at home with your families about our efforts. Pray for the new church plant at meals, as you go to bed, during your quiet time, and whenever else it may come to mind.

These prayer efforts are where we will begin because they will support us throughout the entire process. Nothing else could be as important.
